Development of AutoCAD was started in 1971 by Gerrit Welker, at the time an assistant professor of computer graphics at the University of Utah. The original project was to create a program that could take a picture of a drafting board and create graphics of that shape that could be converted into a blueprint. After approximately two years, the research team had developed a prototype program that could transform the drawing into a computer file. At this point, the program was relatively primitive, although it ran in text mode and was able to handle simple drawings. In 1974, the research team released the first version of AutoCAD and the program became a commercial success. AutoCAD 2 was released in 1975, the first product of its kind to be commercialized in the United States. The program became a mainstay in the architectural and engineering fields, and it was

followed by AutoCAD 3 in 1976. This new version added basic parametric dimensioning capabilities. AutoCAD 4 in 1980 marked the first implementation of "direct editing", a feature that allowed a user to take a picture of a drawing using a graphics tablet, and add or modify graphics in real time. History AutoCAD has been sold since its initial release as a desktop app on microcomputers. In 1982, the developers moved to the Mac, initially working from an Apple IIe computer. For the Apple II GS, a graphics enhancement board was created by a volunteer by the name of Jon Rone, as a combination of a third-party graphics card and the Apple II's built-in display chip. The enhanced Graphics Utility was first released in the January 1985 issue of Electronic Engineering Times. AutoCAD's initial development on the Macintosh involved work from many volunteers, including a group of friends and students at the University of Utah. As the graphic interface program for Apple's Lisa, it was actually the Mac's first CAD program. The developers included Gerrit Welker, who had been a student at the university, and who had collaborated on the development of the original AutoCAD. At this time, the program was simply called "Draftsman," and was a mix of the names for the various programs that ran in a Lisa computer. The program was originally a text-mode program with a command line interface; however, this was soon expanded into the more user-friendly command window interface. The first version, released in December 1982, is version 1.0.

Programming code can be written directly in C++ to extend AutoCAD functionality, and it can also be embedded directly into the.DWG and.DGN drawing files, for the creation of macro functions, procedures, and scripts. History AutoCAD's release history began on April 30, 1989 with release 1.0 (the first version released as the last version free of charge); the last version for which Autodesk would distribute it for free, AutoCAD 2004 (version 2.5), was released on September 15, 2004. The reason for this change was the discontinuation of the AutoLISP ObjectARX layer. AutoCAD 2007, the first release of the new Windows version, was released on June 19,

2007. As with all versions of AutoCAD, it was created by the developers of AutoCAD and is based on AutoCAD 2002. After the release of AutoCAD 2005, which is Windows only, AutoCAD was discontinued for Mac OS and Linux, although the developers released a beta version of AutoCAD for Linux. Autodesk discontinued the AutoCAD 2009 release on December 15, 2008. Autodesk released AutoCAD 2010 on August 10, 2009 as a free download for all of its previous customers. It added support for multiple operating systems including Windows, Mac OS X and Linux, as well as better interoperability with other Autodesk applications such as AutoCAD LT, Revit, and Inventor. It has better drawing performance and graphical capabilities and also includes the ability to customize the user interface. AutoCAD 2011 was released on October 10, 2010. ==== damncabbage As far as I know it's not possible in CSS. (Can you do it on images? I don't think so.) You could do it in a number of ways, including the following: (a) using a group of s (or whatever HTML tags you're using) with a border and background-color, and then using "table" to center the group, and use the "table-cell" properties to get the corners. (b) If you're really tied to CSS, create a set of HTML s inside

of s, then use the properties to get the corners. (I'm pretty sure that doesn't work. I'm not sure that I'd bet the farm on this approach.) (c) Make use of the "image" tags and have multiple borders of different radii, and appropriate ratios of border radius vs. width, with an appropriate gap between. [EDIT] I don't like this approach because it assumes an even-rounded shape; that is, that a border of 50 pixels
