Q: Garbage collection optimization for large memory allocation in Android I am writing an android app that uses large arrays. Each array has size somewhere around 1.5M elements. Is there any way I can take advantage of the fact that I am not deleting my array elements? I don't know how android's garbage collector works, but I assume that a garbage collector can handle the fact that I am not destroying the memory taken by an array element? In my app, there is a long running background operation that modifies the array every 5 seconds, and I want to minimize the memory consumption of the app. EDIT: I am using `Array.copyOf` because it is more efficient in terms of time to allocate the memory than using new array. A: You can have a large amount of data in a `ByteBuffer` and then let the GC handle the rest.
