However, by permitting foreign interests to continue existing legal rights and obligations in the United States, it also protects national interests, which are the "core principles underlying the foreign relations of the United States." See id. at 837, 118 S.Ct. 1708. *804 As noted, the Dominican Republic asks us to affirm the district court's exercise of personal jurisdiction on the ground that it is simply performing a "corporate service" of its parent, the government of the Republic of Panama. The government of the Republic of Panama is the real party in interest in this dispute. The Dominican Republic's argument appears to be that it should not be "subject to the judicial jurisdiction of the United States" because, if the government of the Republic of Panama were deemed to be the sole party in interest, the judgment entered against it would be void as a violation of the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act. See Gov't of the Virgin Islands v. Mills, 634 F.2d 438, 442 (3d Cir.1980) (holding that an attempted exercise of personal jurisdiction over a foreign state that is not a party to a lawsuit is void, and concluding that "[t]he District Court correctly held that this attempted service is void."). We hold, however, that this case does not involve an exercise of personal jurisdiction over a foreign state, and, therefore, is governed by the rule of the first Kiobel. We begin our analysis by noting that this case does not concern the exercise of personal jurisdiction over a parent corporation or other agent of a foreign sovereign. Rather, here, it is the foreign sovereign itself, the Republic of Panama, which is being sued, and therefore the exercise of personal jurisdiction over the Republic of Panama is not violative of the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act. The Republic of Panama is not being subjected to "the judicial jurisdiction of the United States" by the district court's exercise of personal jurisdiction over it here. Additionally, we c6a93da74d
